# Requirements

Completion of the <u>required</u> modules according to the DFCM deadlines is a mandatory requirement of the program. Failure to complete these modules by the deadline will result in a Field Note noting a professionalism lapse, as per the approved DFCM policy. Repeated failures by a resident to complete the modules on time can result in a "2" in professionalism on a Family Medicine ITER.
