

## Head of the Division of Emergency Medicine Job posting

The Department of Family and Community Medicine (DFCM) in the Temerty Faculty of Medicine at the University of Toronto is inviting applications for the position of Head of the Division of Emergency Medicine. The expected start date is January 1, 2022.

The Division of Emergency Medicine is comprised of an academic community dedicated to enhancing medical education, research and innovation in emergency medicine and leading change at the system level. The Head of the Division of Emergency Medicine will lead a community of learners, educators, and researchers working together for the provision of valuable clinical, academic, and leadership services to emergency medicine. The Head of the Division will promote excellence in clinical care, education, research, quality improvement and faculty development.

The Head of the Division of Emergency Medicine will lead the development and implementation of a Division Strategic Plan. The Division Head will promote and support education, research and quality improvement initiatives across the Division through collaborations with Schwartz/Reisman Emergency Medicine Institute (SREMI), affiliated hospital sites, DFCM programs, and the Divisions of Emergency Medicine in the Departments of Medicine and Pediatrics.

The ideal candidate will have certification with the College of Family Physicians of Canada and Emergency Medicine training (CCFP-EM preferred). The candidate will possess excellent leadership, communication, organizational and team building skills, a proven ability to lead and work effectively with others, and a strong commitment to faculty members and learners. The candidate will present a strong vision for the development of emergency medicine in the DFCM. The candidate will have relevant experience as a clinician, teacher, and scholar. The candidate will have attained a stature eligible for appointment at the University of Toronto at the rank of Assistant, Associate or Full Professor.
