Family Medicine residents are required to complete all online modules by the DFCM deadline dates listed below.

DFCM Deadline Dates (PGY-1)	Online Modules
July 30 th	Virtual Care Educational Modules
July – September 30 th	San'yas Indigenous Cultural Safety Training

Requirements:

Completion of these modules according to the DFCM deadlines is a mandatory requirement of the program. Failure to complete these modules by the deadline will result in a Field Note noting a professionalism lapse, as per the approved DFCM policy. Repeated failures by a resident to complete the modules on time can result in a “2” in professionalism on a Family Medicine ITER.
