What is a PCN?

Primary Care Network (PCN) is a local network of primary care providers, including family doctors and nurse practitioners, working together to improve patient care and outcomes.

PCNs aim to connect and integrate primary care services, coordinate care, and improve access to care for patients within specific geographic areas.
