

Brief Overview of the Temerty Faculty of Medicine CPD and OCFP/CCFP Accreditation Processes

	Temerty FOM CPD	OCFP/CCFP
Key Points	Requires support from the DFCM to receive certification; any program idea should be vetted first through the appropriate Division Head/FD/CPD/QI Director.	Nationally advertised or attended CPD programs must be certified through the CCFP. Provincial offerings can be certified by the OCFP.
Application Focus	Focus is process review: evaluates how the CPD offering was developed to ensure best educational principles were applied at each step. Content review is done when required by the Department or another MD.	Content and process review performed simultaneously.
Credits	Can apply for Mainpro+ and Royal College credits	Mainpro+ credits only
Timeline for submission	Minimum 10 weeks in advance (option for faster processing at an additional cost).	Minimum 6 weeks in advance.
Cost	<p>Standard program: fees are assessed as follows: 10% of the registration fee (min \$5.25/max \$26/registrant). Minimum accreditation fee is \$775.</p> <p>Accreditation fees are waived for faculty development and research-based programs and rounds that have minimal registration fees and no sponsorship.</p> <p>Click here for more details. *Please note costs can change, always refer to the Temerty FoM CPD website.</p>	<p>A range starting from \$100.00 + tax (faculty development, not for-profit only) up to \$2,500.00 + tax (for-profit supported activities) (provincially certified).</p> <p>A range starting from \$200.00 + tax (faculty development, not for-profit only) all the way up to \$3,500.00 + tax (for-profit funded activities) (nationally certified).</p> <p>Click here for more details. *Please note costs can change, always refer to the OCFP website.</p>
