Associate Editors receive manuscripts in their area of expertise and decide whether they should be sent for review. Whether you send papers out or not, you make an editorial recommendation and provide a brief rationale for your decision. On average, it takes about 5 to 7 hours a month to fulfill this duty.

Though not required, it would be ideal to recruit someone with experience in clinical trials.

While this position does not pay, you do receive a \$500 stipend each year. More importantly, this is an opportunity to influence the direction of primary care research.
