FRIDAY May 1 2020 This is a firm deadline!	Pre-Application Package Due Date
	Candidates are required to submit a <b>Senior Promotion Pre-Application</b> package to the Department of Family and Community Medicine (DFCM) Departmental Senior Promotions Committee (DPC) in order to obtain feedback regarding <b>readiness for promotion</b> .

Tuesday May 26 2020	Senior Promotion Committee Meeting # 1 Following review of the pre-application by the Committee, a formal letter will be sent to the candidates (by mid June) providing (1) their recommendation along with feedback specific to the application and academic activities and (2) an assigned mentor/consultant (DFCM faculty member).
June 2019	<b>Meet with the DFCM Academic Promotions Coordinator</b> Candidates that are supported to "move forward" are <u>invited</u> to meet the DFCM Academic Promotions Coordinator to review the components Senior Promotion Application Dossier and to receive a USB key for preparing their dossier.
Tuesday June 23 2020	Senior Promotion Workshop #3 This workshop is ONLY for candidates that have are supported to go forward for a senior promotion. A decision will be made on how the workshop will be facilitated closer to the date.
The week of October 5 - 9 2020 This is a firm deadline!	Senior Promotion Application Dossier Due Date! Candidates are required to submit their Senior Promotion Application Dossier (USB KEY).
Tuesday October 20 2020	Senior Promotion Committee Meeting # 2 DFCM Departmental Promotions Committee (DPC) meets to review the application dossiers and identifies additional internal, external and student referees (AS APPLICABLE FOR each candidate. The Committee ensures that referees have no direct relationship with the candidate. The process of soliciting internal/external/student referees begins.

November/December 2020	Once the internal, external and student referee's letters are received, the dossiers are reviewed by members of the DFCM DPC for reporting at Meeting # 3.
Tuesday February 2 2021	Senior Promotion Committee Meeting # 3 DFCM DPC meets to review the final promotion dossier and makes the final recommendation on each candidate.
February/March 2021	The Chair prepares a letter of recommendation (for each candidate) to the Dean providing details on the basis of his/her recommendation
Monday March 8 2021	Submission of promotion dossiers to the Decanal Promotions Committee The Chair's letter + the dossier for each candidate must be submitted to the Dean by this date. An important deadline date for the DFCM!
April/May 2021	The Decanal Promotions Committee (DecPC) Review Process The DecPC meets to review all submitted promotion dossiers for the Faculty of Medicine. If a decision on promotion is deferred, detailed reasons will be provided in writing to the Chair to be conveyed to the candidate.
June 2021	<ul> <li>Provostial Review</li> <li>The Dean makes recommendations for promotion to the Provost: <ul> <li>Chairs are notified of successful/unsuccessful candidates</li> <li>Successful/unsuccessful candidates are notified by the Chair</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
July 1 – 2021	Promotion is effective this date
